

# **ITINERARY**

## Majestic tour of Gujarat (6 Days / 5 Nights)

#### Day I.

Arrive Ahmedabad by Air / Rail in the morning and leave for jamnagar (340 kms./ 7 hrs). Local sight seeing at Jamnagar. Overnight at hotel.

#### Day 2.

After breakfast, leave for Bet Dwaraka (190 kms./ 4hrs.), visit Shri Nageshwar Temple and arrive Dwaraka (30 kms) in the evening. Overnight at hotel.

## Day 3.

After breakfast, leave for Porbandar (130 kms. / 3hrs), visit the birth place of Mahatma Gandhi. Later drive to Somnath (160 kms./ 4hrs.), visit Somnath temple and enjoy at beach of Saurasthra. Overnight at hotel.

## Day 4.

After breakfast, leave to Girsasan (50 kms) and visit Sasangir safari park. Later proceed for local sight seeing at Junagadh (60 kms.). Overnight at hotel.

#### Day 5.

After breakfast, leave fro Gondal (150 kms./3.5 hrs.), visit the famous temple of Swaminarayan and arrive Ahmedabad (200 kms./4 hrs.). Evening free for shopping Overnight at hotel.

#### Day 6.

After breakfast, Ahmedabad local sight seeing including visit to Akshardham Temple at Gandhinagar (80 kms.). Evening transfer to Airport/Railway station for return journey.

## Day 2.

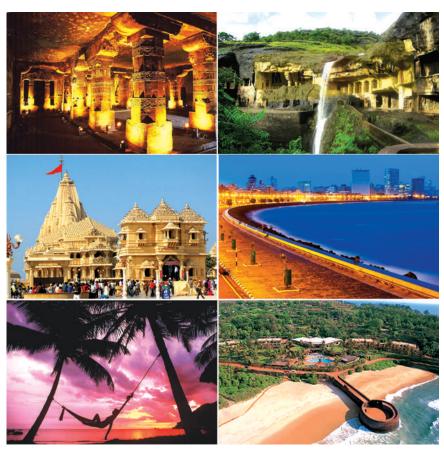

Day I.

Arrive Mumbai

Arrive Mumbai by flight Arrive and Transfer to the hotel. Overnight at Mumbai.

# Day 2.

**Mumbai :** Morning post breakfast, takes a sight seeing tour of Mumbai, drive to Gateway of India and from here cruise by motorboats to Elephanta Caves. A flight of 100 steps takes you to the top of the hill where it is set. The caves houses large pillars that seem to hold the ceiling, which is made, have crossbeams. The picturesque presentations of the 9 marvelous sculptured panels, set on the walls are awe-inspiring. The most famous of the panels is the Trimurthi, or triple-headed Shiva, where the God is depicted as the destroyer, the preserver and the creator. Later in the afternoon cruise back to Gateway of India. Later visit Prince of Wales Museum, Parliament House, Marine Drive, Jain Temple, and Hanging Garden. Return back to the hotel. Overnight at hotel.

# Day 3.

Mumbai – Lonavala (118 Kms – 2 ½ Hours): After breakfast, you will be leaving for Lonavala, the Ultimate Tourist Destination. After you get yourself refreshed we have for you a trip in store, which will cover Karla and Bhaja Caves. Overnight at hotel in Lonavala.

#### Day 4.

**Lonavala – Nasik (100 Kms – 2 Hours) :** Morning after breakfast drive to Nasik. On arrival check in into hotel. Afternoon city tour covering Sunder Narayan Temple – Sita Gupta Caves – Trimbak. Overnight at hotel in Nasik.

#### Day 5.

Nasik – Aurangabad (218 Kms – 4 Hours): After breakfast drive to Aurangabad visiting Ajanta Caves enroute. Ajanta is one of the few historical and architectural marvels of India. Recognized as the World Heritage site today, it was discovered during the 19th century by a group of British officers who were on a tiger hunt. The Ajanta group of caves, located deep within the Sahyadri hills above the Waghora, depicts the story of Buddhism that prevailed here during 200 BC to 650 AD. After visiting Ajanta Caves drive back, Overnight stay at hotel in Aurangabad.

## Day 6.

Aurangabad – Ellora – Shirdi (130 Kms – 3 Hrs Drive): After breakfast take a sight seeing tour of Ellora – 30 km, ½ hours, one of the highly visited World heritage sites of India. It houses 34 monasteries and temples with some exclusive uninterrupted sequence of monuments that date back from 600 to 1000 AD. The temples of Ellora is dedicated to Brahmanism, Jainism, and Buddhism. It also has some of the excellent stonework depicting the legends related to Lord Shiva. Later drive to Shirdi and check in at hotel. Move towards most reputed temple in Shirdi. "The Temple of "Sai Baba of Shirdi". Spend your evening at the sacred atmosphere of Shirdi. Roam around in the spiritual atmosphere. Overnight stay at hotel in Shirdi.

## Day 7.

**Shirdi – Kopargaon – Goa:** Morning Darshan of Sai Baba and later transfer to Goa (overnight train journey).

## Day 8.

**Arrive Goa:** Arrive in the morning and transfer to the hotel. Rest of the day at leisure. Overnight at hotel in Goa.

# Day 9.

**Goa :** Morning post breakfast you will explore the North Goa and South Goa including boat cruises in the river Mandavi. (Boat Cruise depends onthe weather condition of that day). Overnight at hotel in Goa.

# Day 10.

Goa: Day at leisure to explore the beauty of Goa beaches, overnight at hotel in Goa.
