



Day I.

Nairobi/Mountain Lodge or simiar: Arrive Nairobi and drive through Kikuyu countryside to the lower slopes of Mt. Kenya arriving in the hotel in time for lunch. Relax in the afternoon as you watch game from the balcony of the lodge, with an optional guided nature/forest walk. Overnight floodlit game viewing. Dinner and overnight at the Mountain lodge or similar.

Approx Transit time: 3 hrs Meal plan: {L, D}

Day 2.

Samburu or simiar: Depart after breakfast and drive further north across the equator to Samburu National Reserve arriving **Samburu Game Lodge** in time lunch. Afternoon game drive. Dinner and overnight at the lodge.

Approx Transit time: 3 hrs Meal plan: {B, L, D}

Day 3.

Samburu : Full day in Samburu, with an early morning and late afternoon game drive. Samburu is a beautiful and game abundant park, home to rarely found species such as the Beisa Oryx, Grevy's zebra, blue-necked Somali ostrich and reticulated giraffe. Optional activites include a visit to a local Samburu village, camel riding and guided nature and bird walks. All meals and overnight at **Samburu Game Lodge. Meal plan:** {B, L, D}

Day 4.

Sweetwaters Game Sanctuary: Depart Samburu after breakfast and drive back to the lower slopes of Mount Kenya - arriving Sweetwaters Tented Camp in time for lunch. Afternoon game drive in the private sanctuary (Sweetwaters Game Reserve), including a visit to the Chimpanzee Sanctuary, the only one of its kind in Kenya. You will also visit Morani the tame rhino and the Visitors Information Centre. Return to Sweetwaters Tented Camp for dinner and overnight (with an optional night game drives). Approx Transit time: 3 hrs Meal plan: {B, L, D}

Day 5.

Lake Nakuru: After breakfast drive down to the floor of the Rift Valley - to Lake Nakuru National Park, making a brief stop at Nyahururu Thomson Falls. Arrive Sarova Lion Hill Lodge in time for lunch, followed by an afternoon game drive in the park. Besides the flamingos that the lake is famous for, there are approx 400 other species of birds visiting the lake. Also, many species of game can be found in the park including the introduced Rothschild's giraffe, black and white rhino, waterbuck, reedbuck, lion, buffalo, leopard, baboon and many species of plains game. Dinner and overnight at the lodge.

Approx Transit time: 3 hrs Meal plan: {B, L, D}

Day 6.

Naivasha: Another morning game drive in Nakuru, then depart for Naivasha, arring Lake Naivasha Sopa Lodge in time for lunch. Afternoon boat ride on Lake Naivasha and a walking safari at Crescent Island, one of the few places in the world where one can wander on foot amidst wild animals - there are no predators. Return to Lake Naivasha Sopa Lodge for dinner and overnight.

Approx Transit time: 1 1/2 hrs Meal plan: {B, L, D}

Day 7.

Maasai Mara: Depart after breakfast and drive further along the floor of the Rift Valley to Maasai Mara, arriving Mara Serena Lodge in time for lunch. Afternoon game drive as you get a feel of this vast game filled reserve. Dinner and overnight at Mara Serena Lodge. Approx Transit time: 5 hrs Meal plan: {B, L, D}

Day 8 & 9.

Maasai Mara: Spend two days in Maasai Mara, Kenya's most popular game sanctuary where you will have the best opportunity of spotting the Big Five (lion, leopard, buffalo, rhino and elephant). On one day you will go out with picnic lunch boxes to spend most of the day in the

park coming back to the lodge late afternoon, while on the second day you will have an early morning pre-breakfast game drive, and another one late afternoon. There will also be an optional visit to a local Maasai village. All meals and overnight at **Mara Serena Lodge. Meal plan :** {B, L, D}

Day IO.

Back to Nairobi/Out: Depart Maasai Mara after breakfast, driving back to Nairobi to arrive approx I 300hrs. Drop at your hotel or transfer to the airport for onward flight home. End of our services. **Approx Transit time:** $5\frac{1}{2}$ hrs **Meal plan:** {B}

ITINERARY 2

5 Nights - 6 Days

Day I.

Nairobi -Amboseli: Arrival in Nairobi & transfer to the hotel. Pick up from the hotel aand then depart from Nairobi. Drive south through Masai country via Loitoktok Kenya/ Tanzania border and onto Amboseli for lunch.. On arrival proceed for a short game drive which provides a chance to see many animals with Kilimanjaro (Africa's highest peak) providing a beautiful backdrop, dinner and overnight at the camp

Day 2.

Amboseli full Day: Full day of game viewing in the Park. Amboseli National Park is located at the foot of Mt. Kilimanjaro, Africa's highest mountain. The snows of the mountain form a majestic backdrop to one of Kenya's most popular spectacular displays of wildlife - lion, elephant, leopard, rhino,cheetah, buffalo and host of plains game, creating Kenya's most sought after photographer's paradise. Meals and overnight at the camp

Day 3.

Amboseli - Lake Nakuru: Leave Amboseli in the morning after the breakfast, proceed to Lake Nakuru with a stop over for lunch on the way. Arrive in Lake Nakuru late afternoon proceed for the game drive until 1830hrs. This lake provides the best viewing for the white Rhinos as well as Flamingos. Lake Nakuru National Park, where you will have a chance to visit a unique sanctuary catering for a sizable number of the endangered rhinoceros and the Rothschild giraffe. Waterbucks as well as the predators such as the lion and leopard are common at the park. Also to be seen is a myriad different variety of bird-life in and around the lake. Flamingos are also plenty at the lake. Dinner and overnight in the Waterbuck Hottel.

Day 4.

Lake Nakuru - Masai Mara : After breakfast leave Nakuru and head to Masai Mara,the drive normally takes 4 hours to get to Masai Mara,on arrival check in the camp and have lunch,then after lunch we will proceed for the afternoon game drive which takes us until 18.30hrs.return to the camp dinner and overnight at the hotel.

Day 5.

Maasai mara Full day: The whole day explore the parks amazingly high concentration of game. This game reserve is Kenya's finest wildlife sanctuary. Including migrants, well over 450 species of animals have been recorded here. The Mara's gentle fertile climate bounded by The Rift, offers perhaps the richest stocked reserve set within some 1672 sq kms - an unlimited spectacle of wildlife. Located 268 kms west of Nairobi, the emphasis here is on game. Herds of immense Elephants, browse among Lion, Buffalo, Thompson's Gazelle, Zebra and Topi. You may occasionally sight a Rhino or Leopard. In the Mara River Hippos play and Crocs bask on the banks. The annual migration of a million Wildebeest follows the rains north. Dinner and overnight in the camp.

Day 6.

Maasai Mara – Nairobi : Have a morning game drive return to the camp for main breakfast as you prepare to leave the park and head back to Nairobi.Arrive early afternoon with a drop off to the hotel or back to the airport.

ITINERARY 3

4 Nights - 5 Days

Day I.

Arusha to Ngorongoro Crater:

Meals: Lunch - Dinner, Arrive Jomo Kenyatta International Airport . You will be met on arrival and transferred by shuttle bus to Arusha by road. The tour starts with lunch in Arusha town at 1230hrs. 1400hrs, drive to Ngorongoro Conservation Area. Dinner and overnight at the Ngorongoro Wildlife Lodge or Similar. Ngorongoro Crater, a large, unbroken, unflooded volcanic caldera. The crater, which formed when a giant volcano exploded and collapsed on itself some two to three million years ago, is 610 m (2,000 ft) deep and its floor covers 260 km2 (100 sq mi). [5] Estimates of the height of the original volcano range from fifteen to nineteen thousand feet (4500 to 5800 metres) high.

Day 2.

Ngorongoro to Serengeti National Park

Meals: Breakfast - Lunch - Dinner, Today you will descend 2000 feet (over 600 meters) to the floor of the crater for a half day crater tour. Explore the forest areas that are inhabited by monkeys and elephants, the lake area, where you may see the flamingos and the open savannah where the lions hunt for food. Lunch at the lodge. Afternoon drive to Serengeti National Park via Olduvai Gorge. Dinner and overnight at the Seronera wildlife lodge or Similar.

Day 3.

Serengeti Full Day:

Meals: Breakfast - Lunch - Dinner, Enjoy a morning game viewing in the endless plains of the Serengeti for a chance to see the great herds of wildebeest, zebras and gazelles or a pride of lions lounging in the shade. Return to your lodge for lunch and later do afternoon game drive or with picnic lunches do an extended game drive returning for dinner and overnight at the lodge.

Day 4.

Serengeti:

Meals: Breakfast - Lunch - Dinner, Serengeti offers arguably the most scintillating game-viewing in Africa: great herds of buffalo, smaller groups of elephant and giraffe, and thousands upon thousands of eland, topi, kongoni, impala and Grant's gazelle.

The spectacle of predator versus prey dominates Tanzania's greatest park. Golden-maned lion prides feast on the abundance of plain grazers. Solitary leopards haunt the acacia trees lining the Seronera River, while a high density of cheetahs prowls the southeastern plains. Almost uniquely, all three African jackal species occur here, alongside the spotted hyena and a host of more elusive small predators, ranging from the insectivorous aardwolf to the beautiful serval cat.ti to Lake Manyara.

After an early breakfast and final game viewing depart to Lake Manyara national park whose inhabitants include hippos, monkeys, tree climbing lions, flamingos and other varieties of birdlife. Dinner and overnight at Hotel.

Day 5.

Lake Manyara and - Arusha

Meals: Breakfast

Proceed to Jomo Kenyatta International Airport to board your return flight to india.
